**2022-2023 Academic Year Proficiency and Placement Exam Directive**

Both our students who could not complete their preparatory education in the 2021-2022 academic year and our newly registered students for 2022-2023 academic year will take the Proficiency and Placement Exam on Thursday and Friday, September 22-23, 2022. The transfer students and the foreigner students will also take this exam. The exam will be held **face-to-face**. Detailed information regarding the exam sessions is as follows:

**1. Session (WRITTEN EXAM FOR ALL STUDENTS)**  
**22 September 2022 / 9.30 – 12.00 (Face-to-Face)**

The first session of the exam to be held on HKU campus consists of **LISTENING, READING** and **WRITING** parts. This session will last 2,5 hours in total. Information about venue and time:

**2. Session (SPEAKING EXAM FOR ALL STUDENTS)**  
**23 September 2022 / 9.30 – 12.00 (Face-to-Face)**

Only students who get at least 50 points from the 1st session will attend this session. **SPEAKING** skills of our students will be measured in this face-to-face session.

This session, which will be held on **Friday, September 23, 2022**, will be held **face-to-face** at the **School of Foreign Languages building**. The attendees to this session will be announced at [www.ydy.hku.edu.tr](http://www.ydy.hku.edu.tr) web page on 22 September 2022.

**EVALUATION OF THE EXAM**

1. Students who do not take the Exemption and Placement Exam will be placed directly at the basic beginner level.
2. Students who score **at least 50 points** as a result of the first session can attend the second session.
3. Students who score **less than 50 points** as a result of the first session will be placed in the appropriate levels according to the grade they received. Those students will not take the 2. Session.
4. The first session will cover 70% of the exam and the second session will cover 30%.
5. In order to be exempt from preparatory class education, the English Language Teaching Department students must get at least 70 points in total, while students from other departments must get at least 65 points in total. Students who score below the given points will be placed in the appropriate levels and will be subjected to preparatory education accordingly.

**Some points to be considered:**

1. Students who will participate in both sessions must show their ID, passport or HKU student cards with their photographs on them to the examiners for identification. **Otherwise, they will not be allowed to take the exam.**
2. Students are required to be present in the exam hall at the stated day and time. As the exam will start with the LISTENING part, the late comers will not be allowed to enter the hall until the listening part is done.
3. Students are responsible for bringing their exam equipment like pencils, erasers, sharpeners, etc.
4. Make sure that your mobile phones are switched off during the exam.
