INT100 - Welcome to Orientation Week: 24-25 September 2026

What to expect at university

The main difference between school and university is that you are treated as an adult. That means that you now have greater control over how you spend your time and what you study. It also means that your education is your responsibility.

In the three days dedicated to this course, you and your peers will meet each other, faculty, support staff, and administrators. You will be surrounded by people who will support you in reaching your potential and will attend seminars on different topics and learn about the units and centers at the university. Besides, you will have the opportunity to get to know the campus, faculties, classrooms, library, sports facilities, and indoor and outdoor spaces where you can spend your free time and information about the units and centers at our university. You will learn about the various student societies that continue their activities at our university and going to plan to join the societies that suit your interests and abilities, and you will be able to become a member of the society you want.

What is INT100 "Introduction to University Life?"

The INT 100 Introduction to University Life course is organized on **September 24-25, 2026**, to help you get to know university life and Hasan Kalyoncu University better. In order to successfully complete this course, you must regularly participate in the activities in the orientation program.

Attention!

The INT 100 Introduction to University Life is a "1" credit course that all students must take in order to graduate. The letter grade you get from INT 100 is written on your transcript in the first semester you start your department.

What are the obligations of the "INT 100 Introduction to University Life" course?

- You are expected to participate in the activities between **September 24 and 25, 2026**.
- The INT100 course program will be conducted face-to-face.
- Students who attend the seminars and faculty introduction events face-to-face are required to have the relevant section in the handbook approved by the staff at the program venue to confirm their participation at the end of the events.
- The opening program, seminars, career letter writing, and faculty introductions are **MANDATORY** events that you must attend.
- Your grade in INT100 is calculated according to the total number of points received from the events.

How is INT 100 Introduction to University Life graded?

The grade you will receive from this course, which has a credit value of 1, is calculated in proportion to the number of activities you participate in. For the total points obtained from the activities you participate in, one of the letter grades from AA to FF will be given as a success grade, as shown in the evaluation framework. In order to successfully complete this course, you must get at least a DD letter grade. You can find detailed information about the course passing conditions in the article titled Measurement and Evaluation System. The activities are

worth 10 points each. In case of failure to participate in any of the compulsory activities, regardless of the other points received, the INT100 University Introduction to Life course will be evaluated as NA (Absent).

Safety on Campus

The Hasan Kalyoncu University Security Unit was established in accordance with Private Security Law No. 5188. The main duties of the Security Directorate are to ensure the safety of students, employees, and the campus; to take measures to prevent disruption of the living order on campus; to ensure campus traffic and parking order; to prevent theft, sabotage, and vandalism; to ensure that the lost items found are delivered to their owners; and to control the entrance and exit to the campus. In case of any security problem, you can use the contact information provided by security personnel on campus.

Hasan Kalyoncu University Campus Rules:

- Undergraduate / Graduate / Associate Degree students of our university are required to enter the campus by reading their student IDs through the turnstile at the entrance of the campus.
- Guests (parents, siblings and first-degree relatives) who come with our students are obliged to give their identity cards to the security personnel and get a "Visitor Card".
- Announcements/banners/brochures etc. of all events to be held inside or outside the university are submitted to the campus security and submitted to the approval of the "General Secretariat".
- No announcements that do not have the approval of the General Secretariat will be posted on the campus. (Banners given in the morning will be posted in the afternoon; announcements given in the afternoon will be posted the next morning and hung on the designated places/boards).
- Our campus is in a smoke-free air zone. In order to respect non-smokers and be sensitive to the environment, care should be taken not to smoke on campus, not to throw cigarette butts on the ground, and to dispose of beverage cans in trash cans.
- When you are together with your friends, you need to pay attention to your entertainment level and volume levels.
- Warnings of academic and administrative staff should be taken into consideration.
- Security personnel should be assisted without causing difficulties in applications such as questioning and obtaining information within the scope of security measures.

Vehicle Usage Rules:

- It is mandatory to have the vehicle entry sticker given by the security personnel affixed to the vehicles. Vehicles without a vehicle entry sticker will not be allowed on campus. Administrative action will be taken against those who are found to have entered the campus illegally.
- The maximum speed limit on campus is 30 km/h.
- It is strictly forbidden to drive under the influence of alcohol on campus or to try to bring a vehicle onto campus while intoxicated.
- It is strictly forbidden to drive in a way that will harm the environment or people, and if it is detected, the information and report of the person concerned will be reported to the provincial Traffic Branch Directorate by keeping a report on the license plate. The driver in question will also be notified via SMS.
- Those who do not obey the warnings of the security personnel, who argue with them, who insult academic or administrative staff or students who want to warn them, and who harass people with their vehicles will be strictly punished, and the vehicle entry stickers of the people in question will be canceled.

- Administrative sanctions will be imposed on those who forge vehicle entrance stickers or let someone else use their vehicle entrance card.
- It is forbidden to honk the horn unnecessarily, listen to loud music in the vehicle in a way that disturbs the environment, and throw garbage out of the vehicle.
- Vehicles that have been modified in a way that disturbs the environment, have a malfunctioning exhaust system, or emit excessive smoke and noise are not allowed on campus.
- It is forbidden to make demonstrations (convoy, drift, etc.) with vehicles.
- It is forbidden to park vehicles except in the parking lots specified on campus. Hasan Kalyoncu University Traffic Board will apply the penalty point system if the above-mentioned rules are not followed.

On-Campus Penalty Points Table

Violation Type	Penalty Points
Exceeding the set speed limit	10 Points
Failure to obey traffic signs and markers	6 Points
Failure to comply with campus traffic rules	6 Points
Driving dangerously	6 Points
Violating parking rules	10 Points
Creating environmental and noise pollution	4 Points
Reckless driving	3 Points

Violating drivers are warned when they receive 20 credit penalty points. When 40 credit penalty points are completed, the vehicle entry cards are taken from the driver for one (1) year. The total penalty point limit that drivers can use on campus is 40 credits. The vehicle of those who are found to be driving without a driver's license will be taken out of the campus, and a criminal complaint will be made to the Police Department - Traffic Branch Directorate.

Evaluation

The assessment of rule violations covers all drivers registered at Hasan Kalyoncu University. For vehicles that are not in the university traffic records, an announcement is made to the Police-Gendarmerie Traffic. In addition, these vehicles may not be allowed on the University campus again, depending on the nature of the violation. As a result of rule violations, the vehicle entry sticker of the driver whose penalty points total 12 within one academic year is canceled, and this person is not allowed to enter the campus as a vehicle driver during this

period. The situation is canceled by the faculty, school, or administrative unit manager or, if the student is a student, his or her family is also notified in writing.
